Romans 6 (NIV) - Dead to Sin, Alive in Christ

Then we will break up into small groups to discuss the questions listed below. In the event time allows we will come back together and share your group's answers with the entire group.

The Bible is the best commentary on the Bible. However, feel free to use other commentaries or concordance. They can be on-line or printed.

- 1. Read verses 1 to 4. What are some similarities between Christian Baptism and the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus?
- 2. Read verses 5 to 7. Discuss these verses and explain in your own words how we are no longer slaves to sin? What is the definition of a slave?
- 3. Read verses 12 to 14. In what ways can you allow sin to reign in your mind and body? Verse 14 states "For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace." Explain what that means? Use references from both the Old and New Testaments.
- 4. In verse 23 it states, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Explain what that means to you?
- 5. Identify one behavior or mindset that needs to be put to death in your life?
- 6. New Wisdom: What part of Roman 6 spoke personally to you? What did you learn that you didn't know before?
