- 1. Read verses 1 to 6. What principle or idea is Paul highlighting with the death of the husband and the married wife being able to take a new husband? How does this relate to the passage: "that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead..."
- 2. Read verses 7 to 13. Discuss these verses and explain how the "law" and "sin" are related. How is the law itself "good" or "bad"? Explain your answer.
- 3. Read verses 14 to 25. The apostle Paul describes wanting to do what is good but instead doing what is sinful. How does having a relationship with Jesus Christ give you the power to overcome sin?
- 4. Being a child of Christ means that we receive the power to overcome sin in our lives. What is something in your life that Christ has allowed you to overcome?
- 5. New Wisdom: What part of Romans 7 spoke to you personally? What did you learn that you didn't know before?
