- 1. Read verses 1 to 4. In the 2nd part of verse 2, Paul says "...but their zeal is not based on knowledge." Paul expresses his desire that the people of Israel be saved. What is the zeal for the Jews based on? Is this a problem for them? Why or Why not?
- 2. Read verses 8 to 11. These verses describe the model by which the sinner's prayer is based. Recall the time and place where you prayed to receive Jesus Christ for your Salvation. Share one way that "Jesus is Lord" over your life. Explain your answer.
- 3. Read verses 12 to 13. Where is verse 13 found in the Old Testament? What does it mean? Explain your answer.
- 4. Read verses 14 to 21. In these verses, Paul compares the Gentiles to the Jews. Have the Jews rejected the Messiah? Why or why not? What other reasons might there be for the difference in attitude between the Gentiles and the Jews. Explain your answer.
- 5. Righteousness is a major theme present in the Epistle to the Romans. What was the key difference for the source of Righteousness for non-Christian Jews and Christians? Explain your answer.
