

## Romans Chapter 11 HW

1. In verse 1 Paul asks a question “has God cast away His people?” He answers it right away and says “Certainly Not!” Pauls gives some reasons why they are not cast away but, try and find some of your own reasons, verses, promises, or covenants that back of the idea that God is not done with Israel.

2. Verses 16-18 say

<sup>16</sup> For if the firstfruit *is* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*; and if the root *is* holy, so *are* the branches. <sup>17</sup> And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, <sup>18</sup> do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, *remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you.*

Break down this passage, where else can you find a branch being used in scripture?

3. Verse 25 says

<sup>25</sup> For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

Why do you think blindness has happened to Israel and what is the fullness of the gentiles?

4. Where are verses 26-27 found in the Old Testament?

26b The Deliverer will come out of Zion,  
*And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob;*  
<sup>27</sup> *For this is My covenant with them,*  
*When I take away their sins.”*
