3. In verse 4, it states “For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope.” Provide scriptures in the Old Testament that has strengthened you and given you hope.
4. The Apostle Paul gives four scriptures in verses 9 through 12 which point not only to the promises of God to the Jewish people but Gentiles as well. Identify where these scriptures are in the Old Testament.
