1. In Verses 13 and 14 it states, “Enter by the narrow gate; for wide *is* the gate and broad *is* the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow *is* the gate and difficult *is* the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.” Discuss the meaning of the narrow gate versus the wide gate. Share related scriptures.
2. What is a metaphor? Why did Jesus often use this style of teaching? Share other scriptures where metaphors were applied?
3. What is a false prophet and why must we be aware of them? Use scriptures from the Old and New Testament to support your answer.
4. In verse 21 it states, “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.” Explain the meaning and significance of this verse.
5. In verses 24-26, Jesus uses the example of a wise man and foolish man. Explain the difference between the two and the consequences of their decisions. How do these scriptures apply to your life?
